

Job Description of Head of Compliances, (SPPS-II)

1. Benchmarking of regulatory and compliance regimes at state and firm levels with international regulations and best practices, after conducting all-inclusive sectoral analysis
2. Development of framework/mechanisms to operationalize National Compliance Center.
3. Development of National Compliance Policy while suggesting appropriate actionable measures to align national and provincial levels frameworks with the international standards through possible interventions.
4. Formulation of strategies to integrate industrial sectors with ESG, quality other international compliance standards/regulations.
5. Policy formulation and program development to implement a comprehensive ESG, Corporate Sustainability, Health and Safety, and Business and Human Rights advisory services program.
6. Formulate a Master Outreach Plan for industrial sectors to keep them informed with existing and emerging global regulatory compliances.
7. Collaboration with the key stakeholders (including development partners, governments, private sector, and academia) on ESG, Sustainability, Health and Safety, and Business and Human Rights specific initiatives for effective implementation of different state-level and firm level obligations.
