The undersigned is directed to inform that the Geneva Centre for Security Policy (GCSP) has invited nominations for the training on the 25th New Issues in Security Course (NISC): **"Mapping Today's Security Environment to meet Tomorrow's Challenges"** from 5th May to 27th June 2025 at Geneva, Switzerland as per following details:

- Part 1: 5th May – 30th May 2025 – Virtual (fully online module)
- Part 2: 2nd June - 27th June 2025 – In person module taking place at the GCSP in Geneva

2. The objectives of the courses are to: -

- Provide participants with an understanding of new and emerging challenges in International peace and security.
- Expose participants to analytical tools that will help them recognise and respond effectively to new and emerging challenges.
- Enhance participants skill set to be effective security policy practitioners.
- Establish a wide community of security policy professionals from Across the world.

3. Main features of the course are as under: -

(i) **Course Fees:**

With the support of the Swiss Confederation, they are pleased to offer this course free of tuition charges.

(ii) **Travel Costs:**

Travel costs between the home country and Geneva are the responsibility of the sending institutions.

(iii). **Scholarship:**

A limited number of scholarships are provided by Switzerland and other member states of the GCSP Foundation Council through the GCSP Global Scholarship Fund (GSF) upon final selection, the scholarship covers housing in Geneva as well as Swiss Franc 11300 for living expenses during the in-residence part of the course.
